

Queensland Police Service (QPS) Vehicle Immobiliser Subsidy

What is a subsidy?

- A \$500 voucher towards the supply and installation of an engine immobilizer by a registered installer.

Why?

- To reduce crimes associated with car theft and increase security and safety.

How to apply?

- Apply online for a voucher and present the voucher to a registered service provider.

Who is eligible? Cairns postcodes: 4865, 4868, 4869, 4870, 4878, 4879

More information:

There are still 7,000 vouchers available to redeem, and the trial will conclude once all vouchers have been redeemed OR on 30 June 2024.

The customer will use their voucher towards the cost, and the installer will redeem the voucher after the installation. Installers are required to upload evidence of installation.

FOR CONSIDERATION: The trial is only a subsidy of \$500 with some installers or immobilizers costing more and therefore some customers will have an out-of-pocket expense.

Applicants must be the registered owner of an eligible vehicle registered in Queensland, with DTMR classifications of:

- Eligible vehicle types – PCAR & LCOM
- Registration status – current
- Purpose of use – private, commercial, farming

How to apply directly (not online)?

In circumstances listed below, you can request a voucher directly from the QPS if:

- Eligible residents are not able to apply for the voucher online due to lack of access to suitable technology.
- Eligible residents are not able to apply for the voucher online due to suppressed data on DTMR systems.
- Selected victims of crime.
- Other qualifying circumstances as deemed appropriate by QPS program leads.
