Bathroom Cleaning



Toilet

Inside the Bowl:

- Pour toilet cleaner into the bowl.
- Scrub with a toilet brush.
- Flush to rinse.

Outside the Toilet:

- Spray the outside with vinegar or disinfectant spray.
- Wipe clean with a damp cloth.

Shower

Shower Floor and Walls:

- Spray a shower cleaning product on the floor and walls.
- Scrub with a soft brush.
- Rinse with water.

Glass Shower Doors:

- Spray with glass cleaner or vinegar-based cleaner.
- Wipe with a soft cloth or sponge, focusing on spots with soap or water stains.
- Rinse with warm water. Dry with a clean cloth.

Bathroom Hardware

Faucets and Handles:

- Wipe with a soft cloth and vinegar or disinfectant spray.
- Tip for Mildew: Soak a cotton ball with hydrogen peroxide and place it on mildew spots for several hours. Then clean as usual.

Shower

Showerhead:

- Spray a limescale remover or bathroom cleaner on the showerhead.
- Leave it for a few minutes.
- Scrub with an old toothbrush and rinse with warm water.

Mould (when seen):

- Spray a mould removal product on the mould.
- Wait the time shown on the product.
- Scrub with a brush and rinse with warm water.
- Open a window or turn on a fan to dry the area.

Shower Liner (generally every 3 months):

- Wash shower liners in a washing machine with hot water and detergent.
- Hang them up to dry.

Ceiling

Fan Vent (generally once a year):

- Remove the vent cover and vacuum inside.
- Soak the cover in soapy water. Scrub with a brush, rinse, and let it dry.
